1901 American Socialist Party founded

1904 Debs runs for president as Socialist Party candidate

1905 Industrial Workers of the World (IWW) founded

1911 Triangle Shirtwaist Factory fire kills 146 workers

1912 IWW leads Lawrence Textile strike to victory

1912 Debs wins 900,000 votes—6 percent—for president

1912 Debs wills 900,000 votes—0 percent—101

1915 Joe Hill executed by the state of Utah

1916 Adamson Act sets 8-hour workday for railroad workers 1917 America enters World War I

1917 Espionage Act passed

1918 Sedition Act passed

1918 Debs thrown in jail for speaking against the war

1918 IWW offices raided and 165 leaders arrested

1919 Thousands of socialists arrested in Palmer Raids

1920 Debs receives a million votes while in jail
